SCHEDULE 2

SEASONAL SERVICE

AVAILABILITY

Available for seasonal service connections for those members who maintain a second or recreational home or service facilities and whose primary legal residence is other than the address for which service is being supplied. Approval by the Cooperative Board of Directors will be necessary to be eligible for this service class. Service will ordinarily be available throughout the year unless requested to be disconnected by the consumer. (See term: for length of contract.) If disconnection is requested, there will be a \$20.00 reconnect fee plus sale tax. The burden of proof to be eligible for this service class lies solely upon the member. This service schedule will not be available to a primary residence.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Single-phase, 60 cycles, at available secondary voltage.

ANNUAL RATE

Customer charge annual rate \$156.00
All KWH, per KWH rate \$ 0.08360

PURCHASED POWER ADJUSTMENT

The charges set forth in this service classification shall be subject to a purchased power adjustment as explained in the Cooperative's service Rules and Regulations. The charges billed under this section are subject to a late payment rate.

ANNUAL CHARGES

The annual customer charge of \$156.00 is based on a \$13.00 monthly customer charge rate. Seasonal members will be billed during the December billing period each year for their advance (yearly service charge) and KWH's balance for the current year and 1/2 of the KWH's used in the current year to be applied to the following years usage.

TERMS OF PAYMENT

All bills are due when personally served or three days after the mailing of the bill and may be paid in full on or before the "last day to pay" date specified on the bill, which shall be least 20 days after the date on which the bill is rendered.

A late payment charge will be assessed at a rate of one and one-half percent (1 ½%) on a customer's unpaid balance, including service billing arrears and unpaid late payment charges. Remittance mailed on the "last day to pay" date will be accepted without the late charge, the postmark to be conclusive evidence of the date of mailing. The failure

on the part of the customer to receive the bill shall not entitle him/her to pay without the late payment charge after the "last day to pay" date.


TERM

Minimum length of service is one (1) year, after which service may be terminated with forty-eight (48) hours written notice unless other conditions have been specified in the contract for service.
